ELIGIBILITY

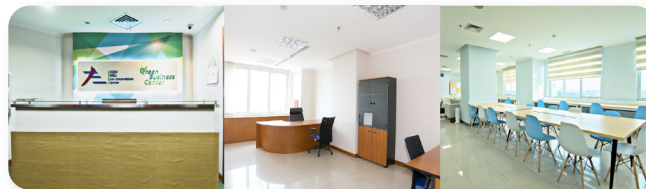

GBC FACILITIES AND BENEFITS

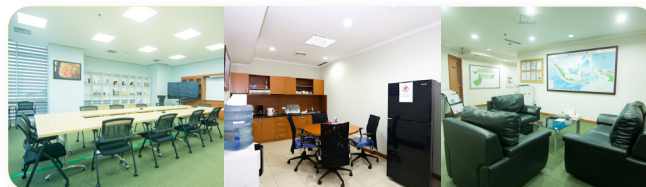
FACILITIES
